Week no.5: Visiting You. Tuesday Design 101 MOOC, Abadir for iversity


Greetings from Kusadasi, Turkey!

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He's a tin soldier man Living in a little tin wonderland Very happy little tin soldier man When you set him on your knee


Something to remember: Don't take yourself too seriously. Design needs humour.

On YouTube:

the Design 101 channel: to view + share our video postcards (which is not possible to do from the iversity platform)

On Instagram: #design101: to connect us all under a same hashtag.
